What do you notice about this story as you read/hear it this time?

What is challenging or confusing as you read/hear it this time?

What does Jesus' statement in v.14 reveal to us about Jesus? His ministry?

Why can Jesus' direct warning in v.15 seem extraordinary?

How does his statement inform our life of faith?

Explore Jesus parable and how it illustrates his teaching.

What does it look like to be 'rich toward God'?

How do you live like that?

What do you need to change in order to be rich toward God?

Read again Ecclesiastes 1:2, 12-14; 2:18-23

What do you notice about this wisdom as you read/hear it this time?

What is the connecting image as this pericope jumps around?

How does this image connect with our gospel story today?

What is the good news proclaimed in this reading?

Read again Colossians 3:1-11

What do you notice about this story as you read/hear it this time?

How does this passage connect to today's gospel story?

How would our lives and our interaction with the world change if we see the Christ in all?

Read and reflect on Psalm 49:1-12 if you'd like.
