What does it mean/look like to abide in the presence of God?

Read again Genesis 18:1-10a

What do you notice about this story as you read/hear it this time?

How is Abraham's welcome ordinary?

How is his welcome extraordinary?

How do you know when a visitor is from the Lord?

What does the extraordinary news of Sarah's pregnancy reveal about God?

Read again Colossians 1:15-28

What do you notice about this story as you read/hear it this time?

According to this passage, what are all the things that 'Christ is'?

What does it mean for us and for the world that Christ dwells in the church? /You and

me?

Read and reflect on Psalm 15 if you'd like.
