How are these verses radical hope for troubled times?

What would you do if you knew the day when the fullness of God comes?

Read again 2 Thessalonians 3:6-13

What do you notice about this story as you read/hear it this time?

How do we work for one another in faith?

How can this passage both be offered as encouragement to faithful living and abused to

cast judgment?

Read and reflect on Psalm 98 if you'd like.
